STEM Club will be starting in Term 1.

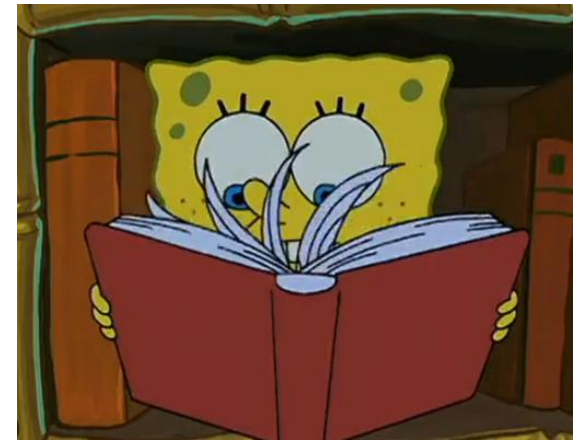

LIBRARY INFO FOR 2024



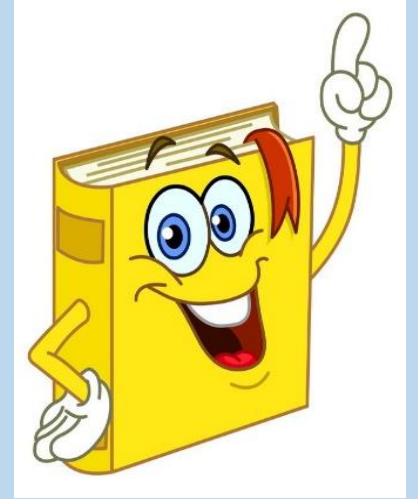
- If you wish to use the library to:

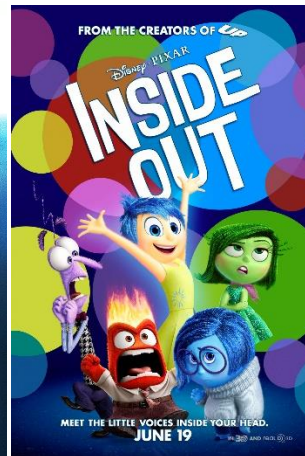
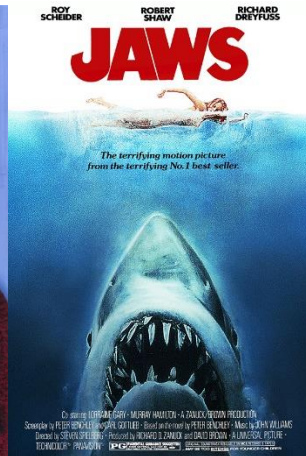
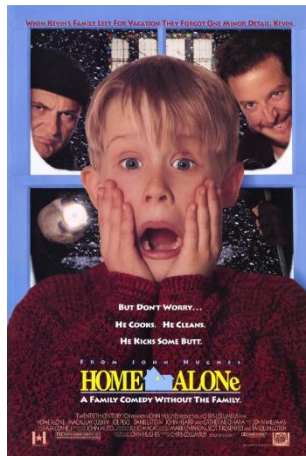
