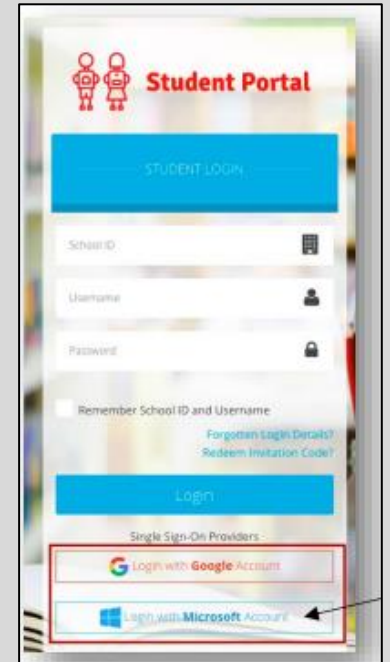
Students will be given credentials by their tutor the first week and shown how to log into RM Unify with their school email and password.

PARENT PORTAL

MyChildAtSchool [MCAS] is a portal enabling parents to view their child's academic performance in real-time via the app or web browser.

This facility allows exclusive access to the child's Attendance, Behavior, Homework and Timetables whenever the parent/carer wishes.

As well as student performance data, the portal also provides general useful information about school such as the Academic Calendar and Announcements.

In summary, MyChildAtSchool provides:

- Access to real-time Attendance, Assessment and Behavioral data
- An insight to parents on their child's schoolwork (homework topics etc.)
- Communication facilities to improve contact between parents and schools
- Instant access to Published Reports and Letters




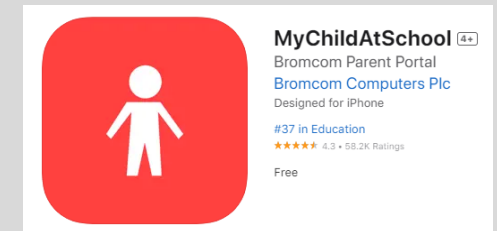

SCOPAY ACCOUNT



At the end of Term 6 you will be sent a letter detailing your Link Code. You will need a Link Code in order to set up your child's account.

At Wellsway School we use Cashless Catering.

Cashless Catering is a computerised system which removes the need for cash being taken at the till point, allowing for quicker serving times. Parents and carers credit their child's online account. The system recognises each individual student, holds individual cash balances, records cash spent and cash received, and records details of items purchased.

On the first day of term, your child will be required to register for Cashless Catering. At this stage each student will have finger image registered. This will enable them to purchase food from our school dining hall and other food outlets on the campus.

By submitting the Year 6 transition information form, you are consenting for your child to have their finger image registered at Wellsway School in September. If you would like to opt your child out of having their figure image registered, please contact Ms Joseph, LJoseph@wellswayschool.com

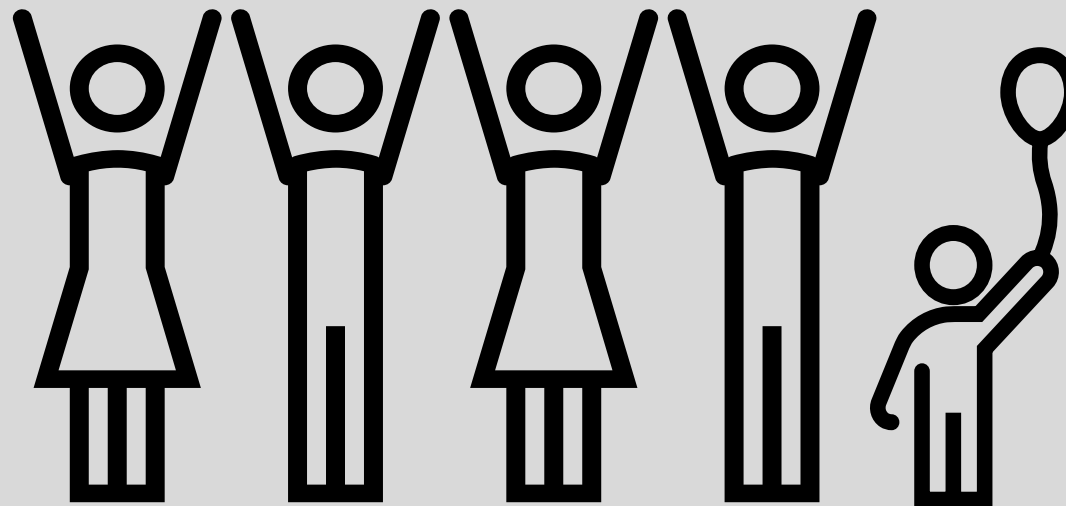

- Our staff undertake **legal training**, and our advice is based on the law.
- We encourage families and professionals to **work together** to help children and young people to **achieve the best possible educational and other outcomes**.

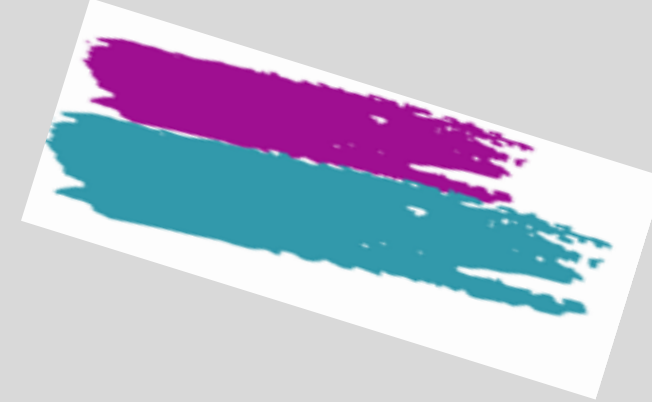
